

## Attachment No. 1 to the CONFERENCE PARTICIPANT REGISTRATION CARD

### Information clause on personal data protection

The processing of the personal data of the Participants of the Conference "Cities of the Hanseatic League - Heritage, Tourism, Development" will be carried out in accordance with the principles provided for in the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation):

1. the controller of the processed data is: Wyższa Szkoła Turystyki i Hotelarstwa in Gdańsk, ul. Księdza Leona Miszewskiego 12/13, 80-239 Gdańsk, email: [wstih@wstih.pl](mailto:wstih@wstih.pl).

(2) The purpose of personal data processing is to organise, conduct and archive the documentation of the Conference, to publish the personal data of Conference Participants (name and surname) and for marketing purposes related to the statutory activities of the Conference Organiser.

(3) Personal data are secured in accordance with applicable regulations, and their recipients may be entities entitled to disclose data to them under the provisions of law and entities processing personal data in the course of providing services to the Administrator.

(4) It is not envisaged that data will be transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area or to international institutions, or that personal data will be processed for purposes other than those for which the personal data were collected.

(5) Personal data in the form of an image may be transferred to a third country or an international organisation (i.e. outside the European Union and to countries outside the European Economic Area) in connection with the posting of a photographic account of the conference proceedings via a social network account (e.g. Facebook) operated by the Administrator or an entity acting on the Administrator's behalf.

(6) Personal data will not be taken in an automated manner and subjected to profiling subject to the activities carried out under the terms and conditions provided for in the rules of the Administrator of the social network and/or social application.

(7) Personal data will be stored until the withdrawal of consent, until the fulfilment of legal obligations (e.g. tax, archiving) incumbent on the Data Controller and the investigation and defence against claims for the period resulting from the running of the general period of limitation of claims.

(8) Conference participants who consent to the processing of their personal data have the right to access the content of their data and, subject to the law, the right to:

(a) have their data rectified,

b) obtain a copy of their data,

(c) to restrict the processing of their data,

d) object to the processing of your personal data, but please be advised that an objection to the processing of your personal data will result in your refusal to participate in the competition if it causes an obstacle to the correct processing of your data,

e) withdraw consent at any time. However, the withdrawal of consent will not affect the processing that was carried out on the basis of that person's consent before its withdrawal.

f) request the erasure of data (except in the case when the Administrator processes data in order to establish, assert or defend its claims),

g) lodge a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection. 9. in addition, the Conference Participant shall have the right to contact the Data Protection Officer ([iod@wstih.pl](mailto:iod@wstih.pl)) and the right to compensation for pecuniary or non-pecuniary damage resulting from the violation of the provisions of General Data Protection Regulation.
